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Activity

- Cut out all the syllable houses along the borders
- Cut out the pictures and place it together in a basket
- Show a random picture to the children and ask them to separate the syllables (you can use one clap for each syllable, or use a drum and stick to let them understand the concept of syllables. For example, the word 'banana', can be separated into 3 syllables 'ba-na-na'. So you may clap 3 times as you say the word.)
- Now add the word to the corresponding house. If the word has 2 syllables, it is going to live in the 2 syllable house.
